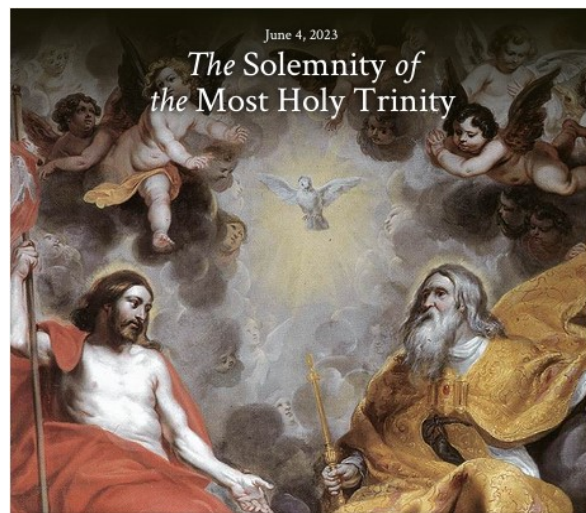

All sponsorship is considered a charitable donation subject to 501c3 deductions, to support our school. All sponsors will be included in the parish bulletin in the weeks after the event.

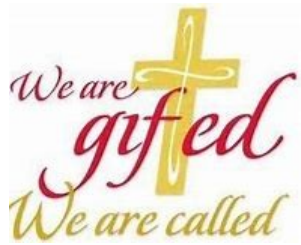

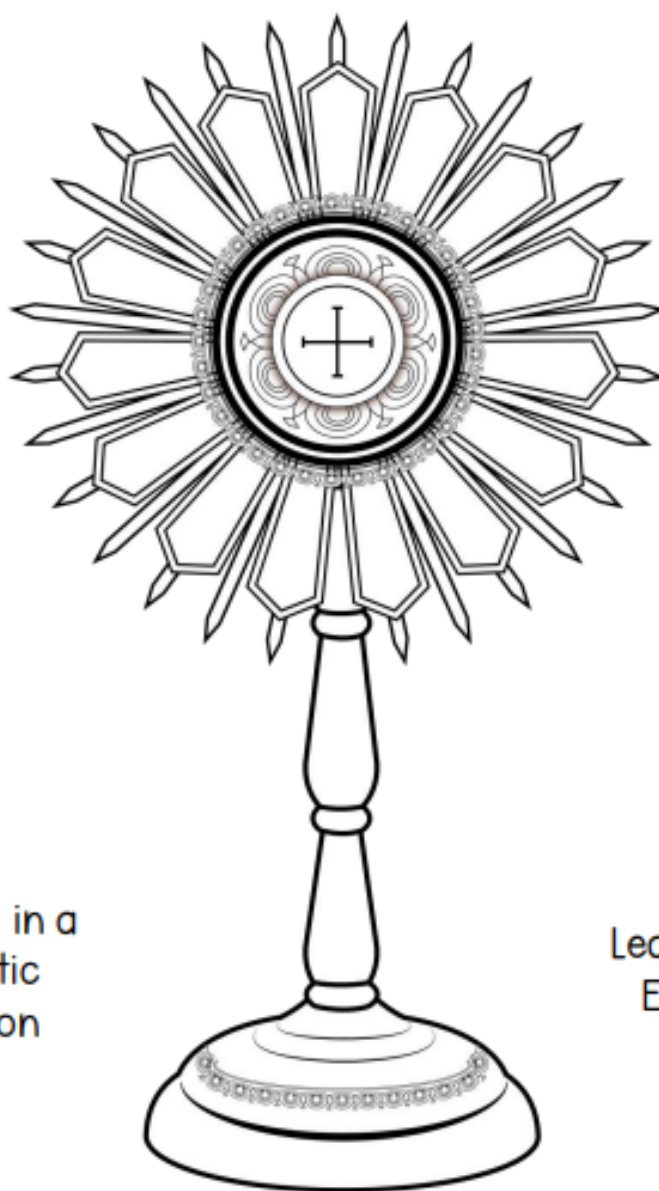
