# Ladies Guild Rosary Altar Society



**SOME STEWARDSHIP THOUGHTS:** In today's Gospel, Peter and his fellow fishermen cast their nets out into the water at Jesus' command and catch a large multitude of fish. We, too, can experience God's abundance when we do as He commands.

On February 11, we celebrate the Memorial of Our Lady of Lourdes. In 1858, the Blessed Virgin Mary appeared to a young girl near Lourdes, France. She directed the girl to prevail upon the priests to build a chapel near a tiny stream there and to pray for the conversion of sinners. In the years that followed, Lourdes has become a place of pilgrimage and healing. This feast invites us to recall the beginning of our discipleship and to recommit ourselves to Jesus, wholly and without qualification, as Mary did, when she uttered her first, trusting "Yes" to the Lord.
